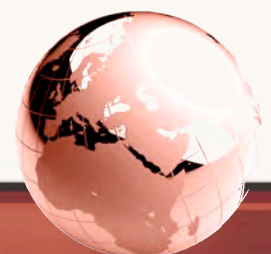
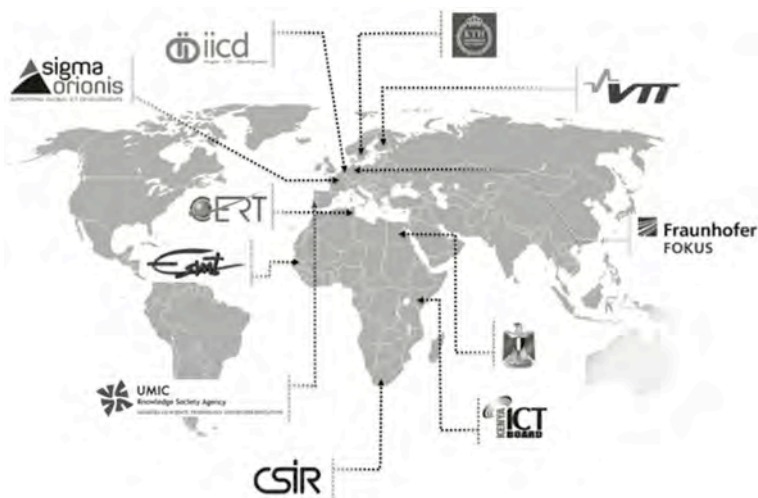


Workshop Objectives

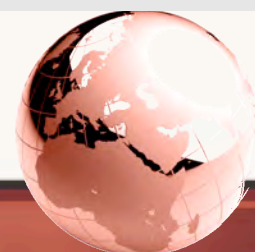

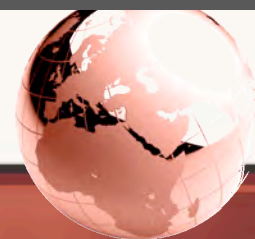
